## A Conversation with Peter Weidhorn



PETER J. WEIDHORN was installed as chairman of the board of the Union for Reform Judaism at the San Diego Biennial last December. Previously he held a great many positions within the Reform Movement, including chairman of the Budget and the NAC (North American Camping) committees, treasurer, and chairman of the Union Relocation Task Force (responsible for the sale of 838 Fifth Avenue and the acquisition of 633 Third Avenue, New York City). A CPA by profession, he is currently the chairman of the board of the Community Development Trust, a privately owned real estate investment trust to promote affordable housing; former president/CEO of WNY Group, Inc., an equity real estate investment trust; and former chairman of the board of CentraState Health Care System.
